**NOTICE** is hereby given that on **October 6, 2011** at **6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Planning Commission of the City of Elk Grove will hold a Public Hearing at the **Elk Grove City Hall, located at 8400 Laguna Palms Way, Elk Grove**, to consider the following application.

**STONELAKE VINES AND SPIRITS – REVOCATION OF THE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (EG-06-1144):**

REQUEST: On May 17, 2007, the Planning Commission adopted a Resolution approving a Conditional Use Permit for the operation of a retail store selling wine, beer, and hard liquor. As part of the approval, the Commission included a condition of approval restricting the hours of operation such that the store shall close at 10PM on weekends (Friday and Saturday) and 9PM on weekdays (Sunday through Thursday).

At the October 6, 2011 meeting, the Planning Commission will consider revoking the Conditional Use Permit. Should the permit be revoked, the store will be required to cease sales of wine, beer, and hard liquor. The Planning Commission may also consider modification of the conditions of approval for the project.
